Now, I was wondering if God/Dad was here because He was going to take me up to visit Heaven, since I had been yearning to do so. Instead, He dropped in to chat with me. What a pleasant surprise, and what a challenging encounter at the same time! I mean how do you talk with The Creator Himself?

Anyways, the visit was short and Dad smoothly withdrew and my wife came back to herself.

Ever since, I have been getting visitations from Dad; at times it would be Holy Spirit, other times it would be Jesus Christ and other times it would be Dad, The Father.

Overtime, I got trained in deliverance ministry under the guidance of Dad. Many times Jesus Christ gave me what to pray for and also clarified things for me.

I remember once I was struggling so hard with one demon that Jesus Christ showed up and told me to take up my authority in His Name, Jesus Christ, then bind that demon hands, feet and to cut off his head. Introduction

When we think about walking with Dad, we often imagine a temporary stroll on a trail, a walk in the park or an exploration in the wild. While all the above does fall under the criteria of a walk with Dad, the most impressive and unexpected walk is the one that lasts a life time; that one walk where Dad takes you on an everlasting journey of romance, adventure, discovery, joy and much more. A total bliss alongside The One Who loves you, enjoys you and knows every little detail about you. The One Who created you for love and to be loved, eternally. The One Who predestined you to be His son/daughter. The One and Only Abba, your Father, Dad!

So, take a seat and buckle up. We are taking off. Reading this book is going to feel like a roller-coaster. Your concept of reality is going to be challenged while your paradigm gets shifted. Your emotions are going to swing from bored to romanced, from flabbergasted to excited, from hopeless to joyful and from inadequate to accepted. Your life as you know is going to change forever.

Chapter I

The Godhead

Just the same as your voice, your personality and your physical body are three (3) versions of you in one human being, all at the same time; so is God The Father, God The Son and God The Holy Spirit, are Three (3) in One and God at the same time; that is The Godhead, The Trinity. Talking to One results in talking to All Three of Them, as Dad.

Oftentimes, we assume that because Dad is good, He knows nothing else but good. However, the Bible says in *Genesis 3:5 (NKJV)*, *"For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."*

Dad knows good and evil. In Heaven He is fully present as good and in Hades He is also fully present as full wrath. This doesn't mean that Dad sends us to hell. No! It simply means that He is capable of evil, but He chooses to be good. In fact because He knows the magnitude of His wrath reserved for those practicing evil, He pleads with us to repent. Better yet, He made a way to prevent us from eternal death, which is being forever separated from Him aka falling off His good grace.

This implies that going to hell is a choice. People choose to go to hell by choosing to remain unrepentant and therefore reject Dad's way for them out of death (being forever separated from Dad).

Nonetheless, Dad continually reaches out over and over to us. Even in the valley of the shadow of death, right when a soul is about to cross over, Dad still reaches out for a chance to get the soul home. All of

this because He loves us and has nothing but good, joy, peace and love for us.

"Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me." Psalms 23:4 (NKJV).

How Dad Talks

Besides the Bible being The Word of God/Dad, there are many ways that Dad uses to communicate.

The same way a human being utilizes his five senses to communicate, is the same way Dad utilizes many ways to communicate with us.

The still small voice

The still small voice is the constant, never changing and ever present way Dad talks to us via Holy Spirit. It is mentioned in *1 Kings 19:12-13 (NKJV)*, *"and after the earthquake a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire; and after the fire a still small voice. So it was, when Elijah heard it, that he wrapped his face in his mantle and went out and stood in the entrance of the cave. Suddenly a voice came to him, and said, 'What are you doing here, Elijah?'"*

Dreams and visions

Throughout the Bible we read that many times, Dad communicated to Israel via dreams and visions.

From Abraham, Isaac, Israel, Joseph, Daniel, Ezekiel, John the apostle and many other prophets, they all received instructions via dreams and/or visions.

As matter of fact, it is written in *Job 33:14-16 (NKJV)*, *"For God may speak in one way, or in another, Yet man does not perceive it. In a dream, in a vision of the night, When deep sleep falls upon men, While slumbering on their beds, Then He opens the ears of men, And seals their instruction."*

The difference between dreams and visions lies within the involvement of our five senses. Dreams and visions can both occur during sleep; however, visions can also occur while awake.

In general, dreams and visions both involve visuals. You visualize things because most of the time your vision is the only sense involved. The difference in the visions however, is the details and clarity of the visuals. Also, visions usually involve more than one sense. At times, it could be vision plus hearing, or vision plus smelling, or vision plus all the other senses.

Depending on where you stand in the spectrum of visions, you can go from just having visuals to having a full blown realistic vision involving all of your senses just like the prophets in the Bible.

The visual stage of visions is like the entry level, on the lower end of the spectrum, so to speak. While the realistic stage where you can see, touch, smell, taste, and hear is like the mature level, on the higher end of the spectrum, so to speak.

The key factor here is to pay attention and to value your dreams and vision experiences with Dad. Then in time Dad will gradually increase their intensity and their frequency in your life.

Therefore, pay attention to your dreams and visions; they are very important in your walk with Dad.

Dreams are most often used for emotional healing; you may for instance find yourself dreaming of a story or a song relaying a certain emotion to help you purge or to help you emotionally regulate. Or you may find yourself dreaming in a time and place where something traumatic had happened to you to communicate a trauma to address in prayer for healing. Or you may find yourself dreaming about an attack

against you to reveal a plan of the enemy (powers of darkness) against you so you can take it in prayer for protection.

Or you may dream or have a vision about receiving a blessing or something that you prayed for to signify that Dad has answered your prayer and so on.

The meaning and interpretation of your dreams and visions are usually tailored to your lifestyle and your relationship with Dad. No matter what they mean, paying attention to your dreams and visions by taking notes and asking Dad for their meanings is the best way to go about it.

Also, remember that the enemy can give you dreams and visions as well. This also translates that we are vulnerable when we go to sleep. Therefore praying before going to sleep and upon waking up is also very important to keep ourselves guarded against the enemy.

Prayer before bed

Beautiful, awesome and Holy God; Our Father, slow to anger and abundant in mercy; I renounce the kingdom of darkness and I say, "Yes" to The Kingdom of Light.

Please forgive me as I also forgive those who have offended me. Please send Your Holy angels to guard me and to put a hedge of protection around me and my loved ones while we sleep.

Holy Spirit I thank You for easing up my mind and thoughts, for clearing up my mind and thoughts and for giving me a good sleep and rest in Jesus Christ's Name.

Father, I thank You for cleansing, closing and sealing every access, gate and portal to the powers of darkness, in and out of perimeters, territories and air quadrants, in the Name of Jesus Christ.

I praise You, I adore You, I glorify You and I have prayed in the Name of Jesus Christ.

Amen!

Prayer upon waking up

Greetings Dad; Merciful, Gracious and loving Father; I renounce the kingdom of darkness and I say, "Yes" to The Kingdom of Light.

Please forgive me as I also forgive those who have offended me. Thank You for waking me up and for guiding my steps to do Your Will today. I also thank You for sending Your Holy angels to guard me while I slept.

Holy Spirit I thank You for the sleep, rest and rejuvenation. I also thank You for my dreams, visions and imaginations, and I thank You for revealing their meaning and interpretation as You see fit. In the meantime, cover them all with the Blood of Jesus Christ.

Father, I thank You again for cleansing, closing and sealing every access, gate and portal to the powers of darkness, in and out of perimeters, territories and air quadrants, in the Name of Jesus Christ.

I praise You, I adore You, I glorify You and I have prayed in the Name of Jesus Christ.

People/Prophet

Dad still talks through people. From a random man at the gas station or a stranger at the nail salon to your favorite preacher at church; or better yet, from your spouse or relative to the mouth of a babe, Dad can speak through anyone with ease.

Think about it, if an evil spirit can possess a human being, wouldn't it imply that they are counterfeiting what Dad does? In fact Dad moves so smoothly that when He talks through someone, if He doesn't give it away, you will never notice it.

In fact, Dad has been communicating through prophets since the beginning. It is mentioned in *Jeremiah 1:7 (NKJV)*, "*But the Lord said to me: "Do not say, 'I am a youth,' For you shall go to all to whom I send you, And whatever I command you, you shall speak."*

Life event

Dad can use a life event to communicate as well. Things like random numbers constantly appearing can communicate a message to you. For instance the number four (4) can mean that a trial is coming, because throughout the Bible, the number four (4) is usually associated with trial. Therefore knowing the Biblical meaning of numbers can be helpful to decipher the message that Dad is communicating to you.

For example, one (1) is the number attributed to something new or approved by Dad. Hence the first day of creation marking the beginning of creation, the firstborn as mentioned in *Numbers 3:13 (NKJV)*, *"because all the firstborn are Mine. On the day that I struck all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, I sanctified to Myself all the firstborn in Israel, both man and beast. They shall be Mine: I am the Lord."*

The number two (2) symbolizes balance, strength and/or unity. Hence Dad created two (2) types of human beings: male and female. Also, Jesus Christ sent out His disciples two (2) by two (2) as mentioned in *Luke 10:1 (NKJV)*, *"After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go."*

The number three (3) symbolizes ministry and/or wholeness. Hence The Godhead being three (3) in One; man being body, soul and spirit, three (3) in one as well. Also, Jesus Christ's ministry on earth started when He was thirty (30) years old, His ministry lasted three (3) years and He was thirty three (33) years old when He died. Not to forget that in order to do service in the tabernacle of meeting, the Levites had to be thirty (30) years and older as mentioned in *Numbers 4:35 (NKJV)*, *"from thirty years old and above, even to fifty years old, everyone who entered the service for work in the tabernacle of meeting;"*

The number four (4) is the number of trial and/or judgment. The children of Israel were in Egypt four hundred (400) years. Moses was on

the mountain forty (40) days and forty (40) nights. The flood water rained forty (40) days and forty (40) nights as mentioned in *Genesis 7:4 (NKJV)*, *"For after seven more days I will cause it to rain on the earth forty days and forty nights, and I will destroy from the face of the earth all living things that I have made."*

The number 5 is symbolic to grace and/or miracles as hinted in *Matthew 16:9 (NKJV)*, *"Do you not yet understand, or remember the five loaves of the five thousand and how many baskets you took up?"*

The number six (6) is the number of man, because man was created on the sixth day.

"Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.'" So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth." And God said, "See, I have given you every herb that yields seed which is on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food. Also, to every beast of the earth, to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps on the earth, in which there is life, I have given every green herb for food"; and it was so. Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day." Genesis 1:26-31 (NKJV).

The number seven (7) symbolizes perfection and/or completeness because Dad ended His work on the seventh day as mentioned in *Genesis 2:2 (NKJV)*, *"And on the seventh day God ended His work which*

He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done."

The number eight (8) symbolizes a new beginning and/or holiness as hinted in *Leviticus 23:36 (NKJV)*, *"For seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it."*

The number nine (9) symbolizes an end of a cycle and/or divine judgment. Hence Jesus Christ died at the ninth hour as mentioned in *Mark 15:34-37 (NKJV)*, *"And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, 'Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?' which is translated, 'My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?' Some of those who stood by, when they heard that, said, 'Look, He is calling for Elijah!' Then someone ran and filled a sponge full of sour wine, put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink, saying, 'Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to take Him down.'" And Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last."*

The number twelve (12) symbolizes government and/or the last hour. Hence the twelve (12) hours on the clock, the twelve tribes of Israel, the twelve (12) disciples, the twelve (12) gates of the tabernacle of meeting, and so on.

At times, a number can be consecutively repeated two (2) or three (3) times, this usually translates something imminent or urgent. For example seeing 1212 translates that the last hour (the end time) is imminent. 1212 is usually a call for intercession, to pray for the world.

The list of numbers goes on. However, these are about the basic numbers to start with. Their meaning may be hard to decipher at times; but, with Dad always being with you, if you ask Him, He will faithfully clarify it for you.

Anyways, numbers are not the only thing that Dad can use to catch your attention. You can also find yourself in a repetitive pattern to insinuate that you should change your lifestyle. For instance being incarcerated over and over and over again, being stuck, surrounded by darkness and so on. These are examples of chain of events pointing toward submitting to Dad for healing.

Either way, no matter what it is, if you pay attention to your life, the events will relay Dad's messages to you.

"And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed." Deuteronomy 31:8 (NKJV).

Nature's signs and wonders

Dad can also use nature itself to talk to us. For instance, that there is a famine or a pestilence in a region will signify that the people living in the region are not repenting. As a result, nature is hostile to the people.

In other words, paying attention to nature's signs and wonders will also communicate Dad's message to you as mentioned in *Deuteronomy 11:17 (NKJV)*, *"lest the Lord's anger be aroused against you, and He shut up the heavens so that there be no rain, and the land yield no produce, and you perish quickly from the good land which the Lord is giving you."*

Animals

Dad can use animals to communicate with us. For example a dog steadily barking at something that you do not see can mean that there is an evil spirit trying to get to you. Or your cat can suddenly hiss and run away to communicate the presence of an evil entity in the surrounding. It is well known that pets can see spirits and usually get alarmed when they see the evil ones. Their responses may vary;

however, if you pay close attention, they will let you know what is going on. Therefore, remember to pray whenever your pet begins to spook you out.

Also, an infestation in your place could mean that there is presence of an evil spirit. From cockroaches to rats, flies and bugs, they could be a physical manifestation of a spiritual presence.

Either way Dad is not limited to our means of communication. It's not even a problem for Him to flat out get an animal to talk to you just as described in *Numbers 22:28 (NKJV)*, *"Then the Lord opened the mouth of the donkey, and she said to Balaam, 'What have I done to you, that you have struck me these three times?'"*

Emotions

One of the most overlooked ways that Dad uses to talk to us is through our feelings. We must remember that Dad is a Sentient Being, capable of feelings. As a result, He created us capable to feel as well. We are created in His image, remember!? Like Father, like son.

Therefore in order to comprehend how Dad communicates through feelings we must first recognize and accept that the feelings truly come from Him. For instance, having a peaceful feeling about a project would imply that Dad is saying, "Yes, carry on with it!"

Or having an unsettling feeling about someone or something would imply that Dad is telling you that you should be cautious or better yet, that should not venture.

Either way, paying attention to your feelings will reveal a whole new dimension on how Dad talks to you.

"and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:7 (NKJV).

Thoughts

Dad can read and communicate through thoughts. It is said in *Psalms 139:2 (NKJV)*, *"You know my sitting down and my rising up; You understand my thought afar off."*

In Heaven, every thought is exposed like an open book. Everyone can read them and communicate through them, from spirit to spirit so to speak. This is one of the common ways used to communicate with Dad and in Heaven as well.

Audibly

Hearing Dad audibly is more common than we think. Contrary to what many believe, Dad is still in the business of speaking directly just like He did for Jesus Christ in *John 12:27-29 (NKJV)*, *"Now My soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour. Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came from heaven, saying, "I have both glorified it and will glorify it again." Therefore the people who stood by and heard it said that it had thundered. Others said, "An angel has spoken to Him."*

Each way that Dad uses to communicate serves a specific purpose. For instance, the still small voice relays Dads constant and gentle presence, while communicating through feelings expresses His emotional nature to us. Meanwhile communicating through nature's signs and wonders would shine the light on His omnipotence, and so on.

The bottom line is that they all carry Dad's Voice and Character to us, and the more we pay attention, the more we learn to recognize His Voice and the more He will continue talking to us, just like a good Dad would.

Therefore, pay attention to Him and He will draw closer to you. It is that simple.

Dad's Love

We all grew up knowing some form of love and everyone swears that their love is the best. However, unless Dad Himself teaches you about His unconditional love, none of us truly knows love.

We all got drunk off the selfish kind of love that tells you that if someone does you harm then it is alright to pay them back. However, Dad tells you, no, that is revenge. Revenge will make you hold grudges, make you bitter, angry, and at the end it will destroy you. So, forgive instead and you will receive peace and healing.

Likewise, we got drunk off the kind of love that tells you that mistakes are not permitted; that they deserve punishment and that they disqualify you from grace. Yet again, Dad tells you that making mistakes is human and that they are for teaching, not punishment. Better yet, making a mistake is painful enough. Therefore, there is no need to bring more suffering on the soul by reminding them of their mistakes. Instead forgive and do like your Dad would. Instead of punishing them, help them clean up; and instead of withholding grace from them, give them more grace by restoring or comforting them for their losses. Yes! That is Dad's nature! No matter what you have done, Dad is ready to forgive, fix it and help you heal as mentioned in *Isaiah 1:18 (NKJV), "Come now, and let us reason together," Says the Lord, "Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool."*

Also, instead of mockery, despising, criticizing and being judgmental when exposing the bad and the ugly from a soul, Dad shows love, grace and mercy.

As a result, Dad will put up a mirror in front of you and tell you about yourself to let you know that despite knowing about your buried bones, He still loves you and wants you to be His. Indeed, He will expose all that is in you without judging you, rejecting you or

condemning you. Dad will address it to you so that you can surrender it all to Him, then Together You can fix it.

Instead of the selfish greedy love that all of us got drunk off from the world, Dad shows us a kind of love that is unselfish and unconditional; the type of love that suffered the most painful death for us so we can live eternally with Him in Heaven.

This is the type of love that keeps coming despite your good, your bad and your ugly as mentioned in *Romans 5:8 (NKJV)*, *"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."*

How else to demonstrate love to His children, but to show it? *"Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends." John 15:13 (NKJV).*

Dad's Love is that agape Love that melts your heart and makes you safely curl up in His Arms and cry, "Abba, Father!"

"Can a woman forget her nursing child, And not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, Yet I will not forget you." Isaiah 49:15 (NKJV).

Also, Dad's Love is not passive like ours, it's not just verbal like ours, it's neither selfish like ours; it's far from it! Dad's Love is active, live and unselfish! When Dad says that He loves you, He means every bit of it, because what He is actually saying is, "I will be there when you need a friend! I will protect and save you in time of troubles! I will provide for you in time of need! I will comfort you when you hurt! I will guide you when you don't know which way to go! I will teach you new things when you feel ignorant! I will heal you when you get sick, ill, or injured! I will give you hope and life when you feel depressed and depleted! I will keep you company when you feel lonely! I will romance you when you feel bored! Even when everyone bails out on you, I will still be there by your side! I will forgive you even when you think that

you're too far gone! I will help you clean up and fix your mistakes each and every time you turn back to me! I will give you more grace each and every time you bring your shame and fears back to me! I will always take you back when you come back, no matter how many times you betray Me! I will always love you, no matter what, My child, and I mean that!"

Yes, Dad's Love is all you will ever need, and when He tells you that He loves you, or when someone tells you that Jesus Christ loves you, know that it includes all of the above.

So, cheer up, Dad's Love is telling you that you belong to Him already. You have no need to perform in order to make it or to receive it! You are already His! He loves you just because you are His child; that is it! All you have to do is to accept it! Walk in it! Wear it and believe it! Of course, this is easier said than done, because Dad's Love is so good that even believing it is a struggle for us. Isn't it?

Think about it, when you grow up in a broken world that demands that you perform harder for some crumbs, it will undoubtedly cause a problem to walk in Dad's Love! You begin to question love; because a Love like Dad's is just too good to be true. Yes, you will become resentful of the very Love that you so deeply long for. Yes, all of the sudden, True Love would not make sense anymore. As a result, when Dad personally demonstrates His agape Love to you, you can't help but cry, and cry, and cry, and ask, "How can You love me like this? Nobody has ever loved me like this!?"

Indeed, you will cry because nobody has ever loved you like this, and that is because nobody but Dad could ever love you that way! You do not deserve it and you surely could not earn it! Yet, as true as Dad's Love is given by grace, so is His Love yours by birth right; even before you were born Dad loved you already!

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations." Jeremiah 1:5 (NKJV).

Now don't get it twisted! That you are dearly loved does not give you the right to disrespect Dad, nor does it exempt you from evil. No! Dad is still King, He is still your Father, and you are still exposed to evil down here.

So, the least you can do is to give Dad the love and respect due to your Father! At least love Him back as mentioned in *Deuteronomy 6:4-5 (NKJV)*, *"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength."*

The secret in loving Dad back lies within obedience; Dad's Love Language is obedience. This implies that to love Dad is to obey Him as Jesus Christ said in *John 15:14 (NKJV)*, *"You are My friends if you do whatever I command you."*

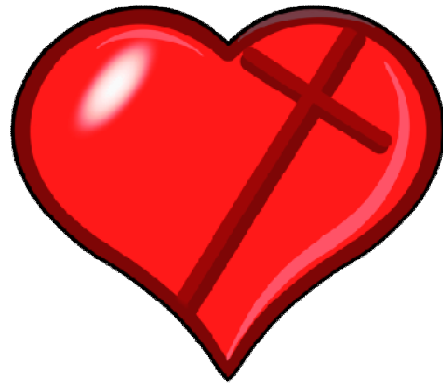
Now mind you, that you love Dad and that you follow His command is not so that you can receive His love. No, it is so that you can align yourself to receive all the good things that He has for you as mentioned in *Deuteronomy 6:17-18 (NKJV)*, *"You shall diligently keep the commandments of the Lord your God, His testimonies, and His statutes which He has commanded you. And you shall do what is right and good in the sight of the Lord, that it may be well with you, and that you may go in and possess the good land of which the Lord swore to your fathers,"*

Just as the scripture says, it is so that it may be well with us! Dad's Love is graciously given, but it takes effort on our end to receive It!

In other words, we are being called into a relationship with Dad, and just like any other relationship, effort is required from both parties in order to make the relationship work.

Relationship With Dad

Working on our relationship with Dad is how we align ourselves with Him; it is at the same time the ultimate protection against the powers of darkness.

So don't fool yourself into believing that developing a relationship with Dad is a piece of cake! No, it calls for daily prayer, Bible reading, mediating, fasting, doing communion, repentance, obedience, choosing the Light over the darkness and so on.

Remember this; if Jesus Christ was crucified because He is The Light, what do you think that they're going to do to you, who are a follower of the Light? In fact Jesus Christ said in *Luke 9:23-24 (NKJV)*, *"Then He said to them all, 'If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it.'"*

Denying and dying to self means letting go of all of your principles, walls, sinful desires and wicked ways of life in exchange for Dad's Way through Jesus Christ. This implies that you are your worst enemy.

All along, don't forget to carry your cross, which are the consequences of choosing to surrender it all to Dad. This implies that the world is going to be your enemy as well, because man (the world) loves darkness rather than light as mentioned in *John 3:19 (NKJV)*, *"And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil."*

In the mean time, as you stand for righteousness and choose to follow Christ, the devil aka the powers of darkness will target you as their worst enemy. They (the powers of darkness) don't really need a reason to attack you. From the moment you were born a child of Dad,

they are at enmity with you. The same as you have a birth right to Dad's Love, you also have a birth right to the devil's hatred. They (the powers of darkness) hate you with a passion! Consequently, your birth right is reason enough for the powers of darkness to war against you. Heck, you are going to inherit all things while they receive shame and condemnation. So, they're not going to sit around and watch you rise up to the top at their detriment. No, no, no! They will do all that is in their power to try to stop you; that is the only card that they have to play. They already know that they can't defeat Dad and they also know that they can't change their fate, so all that they have left is to try and prevent you from walking in your identity as a son/daughter of Dad.

In sum, not only do you have yourself to fight, but you will have the world and the powers of darkness at your tail as well; but don't lose heart.

The good news is that Dad is Omnipotent and He's always with you to help you. He is not going to leave you nor forsake you.

Sure, Dad is not going to take your cross away, but He is surely going to carry it with you like He did with Jesus Christ in *Matthew 27:32 (NKJV)*, "*Now as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name. Him they compelled to bear His cross.*"

Indeed, Dad is going to help you; however, there is no easy way to say this, neither is there a softer way to call it; the inevitable is that you are going to be crucified on your cross, just as Christ got crucified on His. Yes, the world is going to crucify you on the cross that you're carrying.

Developing a relationship with Dad is going to cost you your life. Isn't that the greatest love; to lay down your life for the one you love? Well, you are called to put your life where your love is! Demonstrate your love by laying down your life! That is the ultimate test of love and that is where you are headed.

So, don't back down! If that is what it takes, so be it! To die in this world for Christ's sake is to stand in glory with Him for eternity. Fair

enough, laying down your physical life in exchange for an eternal glory is a small sacrifice to pay if you ask me! The eternal glory outweighs this temporary life anyway.

So, lay aside timidity and lukewarmness and instead press on and run the race with endurance as mentioned in *Hebrews 12:1-2 (NKJV)*, *"Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."*

How To Stand In Dad's Presence

The first time I had a visitation from Dad, I didn't know how to act. I thought I had to perform by talking a certain way, by not mentioning certain things and so on. I could not have been more wrong in thinking that way. Little did I know acting this way is exactly how you prevent yourself from future visitations!

Dad wants the authentic you! No mask, no filter! You, just as you are! No secret and no pretense! The raw, wild, unfiltered and authentic, you; that is who He is after, because that is who He can work with!

This took me awhile to work on, because I always thought that I would get punished for bringing my struggles to Dad. Worst yet, I always thought that Dad will strike me down for showing Him the sin that I was wrestling with! Come to think about it, I learned that from my earthly parents. However, Dad is not like that.

Actually, that sounds silly when you think about it! Dad already knows about your struggles and sins, don't you think!? If He were to punish you for it, He would have done so already. Wouldn't He?

Anyways, Dad is after the honest, you. That you become honest and responsible enough to admit your wrongs/struggles and that you man up in your life by repenting from your sins.

In other words, Dad cannot work with you unless you become true to yourself.

Let me put it this way. Jesus Christ once asked me (during a visitation) if I were hungry, but right before I answered Him back, He replied, "Don't lie to Me!"

I felt hurt, because I said within myself, "Why would I lie to You? That would be foolish!"

Indeed, it was foolish, and I was being foolish alright! I had no idea then what it meant to be truthful.

For instance, when Jesus Christ asked me if I were hungry, if I were to say, "no" or "not really" just because I wanted to be nice to Him, I would not have been honest with Him and therefore I would not have been truthful with Him. Right there is where I would have lied to Him for not being honest!

Then, if I were to say, "yes" and acted all happy because I didn't want to show my true feelings to Him, I would not have been sincere with Him and I would not have been truthful to him again. Right here I would have also lied to Him for not being sincere! This means that not being honest or not being sincere are the same as lying to Dad.

Upon receiving that revelation, I felt so convicted and ashamed that I repented from all the times I wasn't being honest or sincere. Not only was I lying to myself and to others by doing so, but I was lying to Dad as well.

So, now go figure what it takes to stand in Dad's presence! I had to retrain myself to let my true feelings out, to be honest, sincere and to be authentic (no mask whatsoever) in order to be able to stand in Dad's presence. In other words, I had to become childlike in order to stand in Dad's presence! No wonder it is said in *Matthew 18:2-4 (NKJV)*, "*Then Jesus called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them, and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little*

children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven."

Being able to stand in Dad's presence on earth (during visitations) is no different from being able to stand in Dad's presence in Heaven. As a matter of fact, one of the reasons why many are not able to go see Dad in the Throne Room (where Dad is seating on His Throne) in Heaven, or even get to see Jesus Christ in Heaven for that matter, is because they did not learn to stand in truth. As a result, they would need to be taught (even in Heaven) how to become childlike before they can stand in Dad's presence.

Chapter II

The Universe

Growing up watching sci-fi television programming had put into perspective what the Universe looks like. Or should I say, what we are being told that Universe looks like.

Nevertheless, when you begin to think critically, you will quickly find out that no scientist ever got out of the solar system, let alone the so called "milky way galaxy."

So, if no scientist ever got out there! How can they tell me with certainty that what they are stating is true?

While looking at what is out there through the telescope, no matter how sophisticated that telescope is, it still does not negate the fact that they are standing on Earth giving their best theory on how things are. Not to mention that the sci-fi television programs are computer generated.

Either way they are all based on a prognosis of an earthly scientist who never left Earth.

Now let's not jump into conclusions, so quickly! I am not saying that scientists are not seeing anything nor am I saying that all they're saying is a lie! After all, a lie must be based on the truth in order to stand. This means that somewhere there is truth in what we are being told. For instance, the truth is that there is a Universe. We all agree on that truth and reality. The question however, is what the Universe is made of and what It actually looks like.

Therefore, let's consider this scenario. What if the so called galaxies are none other than different Heavens out there, but because they can only be observed through a telescope and through the

distortion of the sea of darkness of the outer space, they do not look the way they should (to us)? This could mean that the Universe is populated with stars and Heavens instead of suns, galaxies, and so on! Moreover, what if the sea of darkness has a limit and does not cover the entire universe because the stars and Heavens provided enough light to light up the regions of the universe beyond the darkness?! Wouldn't this actually change our entire perspective on the Universe?

So, let's back it up a couple of knots. Let's go directly to the source, let's go to Dad, The Creator Himself, because I doubt the Universe is really what we are being told it is.

The Bible said in *Genesis 1:1 (NKJV)*, *"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."*

Simply put! There we have the Universe: the Heavens and the Earth.

When it comes to the so called "galaxies" the Bible says that they are stars and that they were created on the fourth day according to *Genesis 1:16-19 (NKJV)*, *"Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also. God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth, and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good. So the evening and the morning were the fourth day."*

No need to complicate things here. The stars, like the sun and moon, are luminaries.

Moreover, according to the Bible, we (as mankind) live in the first heaven, Earth. The second heaven is the outer space occupied by the powers of darkness; and the third heaven and above is The Kingdom of Light, what we actually call Heaven, so to speak.

This means that the Universe is constituted of spirit beings from the second heaven and above and of physical beings (mankind) from Earth.

The spirits beings either belong to The Kingdom of God aka The Kingdom of Light or to the kingdom of darkness aka the powers of darkness. These are the only two Kingdoms out there and they are at war over our souls.

The Kingdom of God is ruled with wisdom, power and love by the Godhead, God The Father, God The Son and God The Holy Spirit.

"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." Matthew 6:33 (NKJV).

The Kingdom of God is our home and It triumphs over the kingdom of darkness.

They (the kingdom of darkness) are subdivided in many sub kingdoms and ruled with hatred, evil and fear by high ranking evil entities.

The same as we have rulers over specific regions in our physical world, so do the powers of darkness have high ranking evil entities ruling over specific subdivisions and regions. An example of this is found in *Daniel 10:13 (NKJV)*, *"But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days; and behold, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia."*

In this passage, Archangel Gabriel, the one talking to the prophet Daniel, was referring to an evil entity who withstood him twenty-one days; to the point that Archangel Michael had to come and help him.

So we see that the powers of darkness also have governing bodies. They cause chaos, nonetheless they remain organized in ranks, hierarchy; worst yet, they respect them. That being said, they assign evil spiritual rulers in correspondence to our physical territories and in return, those evil rulers aka principalities, are then subordinated to higher ranking evil rulers of subdivisions of the kingdom of darkness.

Some of the most common subdivisions of the kingdom of darkness are: The Nahash/serpent kingdom ruled by Leviathan.

"In that day the Lord with His severe sword, great and strong, Will punish Leviathan the fleeing serpent, Leviathan that twisted serpent; And He will slay the reptile that is in the sea." Isaiah 27:1 (NKJV).

The earth kingdom aka land of the living ruled by death.

"O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?" I Corinthians 15:55 (NKJV).

The fire kingdom aka Hades.

"And being in torments in Hades, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. Then he cried and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.' " Luke 16:23-24 (NKJV).

The marine kingdom ruled by the mermaid aka the mothers of the Nephilim; the women who agreed to procreate with the fallen angels. They were cursed to be sirens/mermaids according to the Book of Enoch.

"And the women also of the angels who went astray shall become sirens." The Book of Enoch 19:2.

The air kingdom ruled by Satan.

"in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience," Ephesians 2:2 (NKJV).

One important point to address here is that Lucifer as mentioned in *Isaiah 14:12 (NKJV)*, *"How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations!"*

This entity that was formally known as Lucifer is also known as Leviathan, Satan, the dragon and the Devil. These are names and

identities that he portrays. What better to expect from a deceiving Machiavellian shape shifter! Of course, he is going to disguise himself under many forms to serve his evil purpose.

In Hebrew, Leviathan means "the twisted one", or "coiled creature" and this depicts his serpent nature. Meanwhile Satan means "adversary", "accuser", or "opposer".

In Greek the word devil (diabolos) means "slander", "accuser", or "one who divides" and the list goes on.

The key scripture confirming that we are indeed dealing with the same evil entity is found in *Revelation 12:9 (NKJV)*, *"So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him."*

He is indeed the same entity called the prince of the air according to *Ephesians 2:2 (NKJV)*, *"Therefore he occupies various positions within the kingdom of darkness."*

They (the kingdom of darkness) are structured in a way that each subdivision has their way of operating and each subdivision has their way of tormenting souls as well. This means that Hades is not the only place of torment. As a matter of fact, it is written in *Revelation 20:13-15 (NKJV)*, *"The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire."*

In deliverance ministry, it is common to come across souls that are held captive and tormented within a victim (a person being tormented by evil spirits).

Some high ranking evil entities take pleasure in assigning low ranking evil spirits to torment captive-souls and then proceed into

storing them (the captive-souls and the evil spirits assigned to torment the captive-souls) within the body of a living victim. This turns the living victim into a chamber of torment while being tormented as well.

Anyways, every one of us gets to choose which kingdom to serve while alive, and depending on our choices, we will either be enslaved to the powers of darkness or be free in The Kingdom of God where we belong. The choice is ours to choose whom we will serve.

"And if it seems evil to you to serve the Lord, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Joshua 24:15 (NKJV).

Now, when it comes to dealing with the high ranking evil entities (Leviathan/Satan, death, the Queen of the sea aka Mamiwata, Moloch, Baal, and so on) that are rulers of subdivisions within the kingdom of darkness, just remember that because their time has not yet come to be judged, rebuking them might not be the way to go about ridding them. You will only aggravate them if anything. So, instead, use your authority in the Name of Jesus Christ to destroy their legal rights, access, control, spells, influence and attacks over yourself or a victim. This is how we can be set free from them.

For instance, in a case of a victim in need of deliverance; as a starter, the minister performing deliverance will begin by asking Holy Spirit to lead the process. Then the minister will rub some anointing oil on their hands before praying over the victim. Then while praying (over the victim), they would gently lay their hands on the affected areas (where Holy Spirit guides them to touch on the victim's body).

The laying of hands while praying over the victim in this case is necessary because of the transfer of Holy Spirit Fire from the deliverance minister to the victim. The Bible says in *Mark 8:23 (NKJV)*, *"So He took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the town. And*

when He had spit on his eyes and put His hands on him, He asked him if he saw anything."

The laying of hands and the touching of affected areas on the body of the victim are symbolic, because as the minister touches, Holy Spirit flows through to consume the attachments from the powers of darkness.

In our prayer example applicable between a minister and a victim, we are going to target Leviathan as a high ranking evil entity.

Feel free to change up the prayer to fit your need and/or replace "victim" with the victim's name.

Prayer of Deliverance From Leviathan

Abba, Father, Glorious and Perfect loving Father; we come to You today just as we are to say, "Yes" to You.

Please forgive us as we also forgive those who have offended us and please put a hedge of protection around us and our loved ones as we go to war against the powers of darkness.

Holy Spirit come, we invite You and we call upon Your Fire to come in this place and in us. Come and have Your way, Lord. Let Your Fire flow through us as we exercise the authority and power that You have graciously given us in the Name of Jesus Christ as mentioned in Luke 10:19 (NKJV), "Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you."

So, with that power and authority given to us in the Name of Jesus Christ, we renounce Leviathan, we break, destroy, dissolve, sever and cover with the Blood of Jesus Christ every curse, alliance, covenant, bond and tie between the victim, their bloodline and Leviathan, and we destroy and consume with the Fire of Holy Spirit, Leviathan's scales off the victim's eyes. We crush, destroy and consume every serpent, scorpion and every power from Leviathan in the victim's life and body in the Name of Jesus Christ. We command every serpent, scorpion, and every

power of Leviathan to leave the victim in the Name of Jesus Christ. Take up all of your belongings, your heartburn, cancers, cysts, fibroids, diseases, sicknesses and be consumed by the Fire of Holy Spirit in the Name of Jesus Christ. Be cast into the abyss and don't come out but under the command of Jesus Christ. We command the body of the victim to repel all venom and poison from Leviathan and his serpents in the Name of Jesus Christ.

Holy Spirit we thank You for setting the victim free from the grip of Leviathan and we thank You for healing and restoring them: body, soul and spirit. We also thank You for pouring Your Living Waters over the victim to wash them clean in the Name of Jesus Christ.

Father, we thank You for cleansing, closing and sealing every access, gate and portal to Leviathan, in the Name of Jesus Christ.

We praise You, Mighty and Awesome Father, we adore You, we glorify You, we magnify You, and we have prayed in the Name of Jesus Christ.

Amen!

What Is A Heaven

A heaven is, for lack of a better term, a celestial place and a reality at the same time. Take the Earth for instance, the first heaven. Earth is a place with its reality. In that earthly reality, we use physical matter to build in our reality.

In the same manner, the second heaven, that is the darkness out in space, which is also a place with its reality; darkness is the matter used to build in that reality. In the third heaven and above, which is

also a place with its reality, light is the matter used to build in that reality, and so on. As a result the beings from each heaven are respectfully made of the matter corresponding to their heaven/reality.

Angels And Demons

To the best of my understanding, angels and demons are both made of energy.

"Then a spirit passed before my face; The hair on my body stood up." Job 4:15 (NKJV).

The presence of a spirit is usually accompanied by an energy field. Hence the goose-bumps we feel, that is because spirits are made of energy. However while angels feed off the light energy, the demons aka fallen angels (because they were once angels as well) feed off darkness (dark energy) and therefore they became dark because they have rejected the light when they fell and left their home (The Kingdom of Light).

The spirits of the Nephilim (sons of another group of fallen angels) on the other hand, they were cursed to become evil spirits because they are hybrid between physical and spiritual (fallen angels). They were born of a combination of darkness (from the fallen angels) with earthly/physical beings, and this combination produced a dark spirit within the Nephilim from conception; a spirit incline to evil from birth. As a result, once disembodied through the destruction of their physical bodies, they (the Nephilim) live on as evil spirits wandering the earth.

As a side note, in spiritual warfare, demons who suffered injuries during a battle can regenerate themselves through dark energy while the spirits of the Nephilim cannot. Therefore, once injured in battle,

they (the spirits of the Nephilim) remain injured and carry on a disability. Angels on the other hand regenerate through the light.

Anyways, demons and the spirits of Nephilim can all be called evil spirits because they are spirits and because they all serve the same evil purpose. Nonetheless, when it comes to abilities and origins, demons are indeed different from the spirits of Nephilim.

For a an elaborated understanding on the Nephilim Please refer to **Chapter IV** of ***A Deliverance Manuel*** by Underground Preacher.

Glorified Body

The glorified body stems from *1 Corinthians 15:42-44 (NKJV)*, "*So also is the resurrection of the dead. The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption. It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power. It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.*"

After the rapture we are going to have glorified bodies. These are our resurrected bodies that Dad is going to rise up for us to live with for eternity.

Contrary to the physical body that we already have down here, the glorified body will neither be male nor female. Sure, we'll still look masculine and feminine, but there will be no more gender. Moreover, the glorified body will not age, will not emit odor, and will not carry waste. Furthermore, the glorified body will stop growing in appearance when it gets to the perfect age, which is the preferred appearance that the soul would like to keep forever. As a result, some of us might look aged, while others will look young or even look like children in Heaven.

Also, growth in the glorified body will not be based on nutrition and age like on earth, but rather based on wisdom.

Don't get it wrong, the glorified body will eat; however, food will be more for refreshment and enjoyment than nourishment.

"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God." ' " Revelation 2:7 (NKJV).

Moreover, in regards to nourishment, the glorified body will be receiving intellectual nourishment as well, and we already know that knowledge can be consumed as food in Heaven as mentioned in *Revelation 10:9 (NKJV)*, *"So I went to the angel and said to him, "Give me the little book." And he said to me, "Take and eat it; and it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth." "*

In addition to eating, the glorified body will also have moment of rest, baths and much more. Some things will remain similar like down here while other things (like being bored, getting tired, grooming, etc.) will become obsolete.

For instance, resting in a bed for a glorified body will be more for enjoyment than to refresh; while bathing will be for cleansing as it were on earth. Note, however that the type of cleansing there is in regards to memories; to let Holy Spirit's Living Waters flow through the glorified body in order to wash away unwanted memories from earth.

This is only an aspect on how the glorified body will continue to grow in holiness in Heaven. Yes! The glorified body will be forever growing in holiness.

Some negative thoughts might even linger, but because no one in Heaven acts on them, there will be no sin. Instead, whenever a negative thought comes in someone's mind, the souls nearby will come around to comfort the soul (the one having the negative thoughts) and thereupon help the soul to overcome the negative thoughts.

For instance a soul can get jealous in Heaven, but instead of being envious and instead of acting on that jealousy (to commit a sin), the soul would rather get comforted by loved ones, get taken to the River of Life for a bath, get the negative thoughts washed away and thereupon grow in wisdom instead.

Rest assured that the process of growth in Heaven is safe and painless. No one is going to laugh at you or judge you. Everything is done out of love and out of care in Heaven.

The New Jerusalem

The new Jerusalem is the Holy City built by Dad for us. This city is described in *Revelation 21:22-27 (NKJV)*, *"But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its light. And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it. Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there). And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it. But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life."*

The New Jerusalem is built with gold and gemstones; It is clean, pure and holy; and nothing unclean, impure or unholy is allowed in there. There is no death, rottenness, dirt or stench; everything in there is forever clean and fresh. Holy Spirit is in control of everything and as a result, total surrender is required in order to be allowed in the New Jerusalem.

So, here is a reality check; not everyone in Heaven gets to dwell in the New Jerusalem, better yet, not everyone who goes to Heaven gets to

go see Dad in the Throne room. They will eventually get there, but depending on their level of growth the process might take a few millenniums. But, hey, what is a thousand (1,000) years compared to eternity, a micro drop in a bucket? Not even close! So relax no need to panic. By the time you make it in, eternity wouldn't have started yet!

Still, if you insist on entering the Holy City sooner, just know that you will have to surrender it all to Dad while you're still down here. Moreover, you will have to learn to praise and to give thanks to Dad while you're at it, because that is how you will enter through His gates as mentioned in *Psalms 100:4 (NKJV)*, *"Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name."*

That being said, anyone who never learned to praise Dad while on earth, in Heaven they will be held in the outer perimeters in order for them to learn to praise Him before entering at the gate of Heaven. Afterwards, they will have to work on their purity in order to stand before Dad as mentioned in *Matthew 5:8 (NKJV)*, *"Blessed are the pure in heart, For they shall see God"*

Indeed Jesus Christ paid the price so that we can have eternal life. Nonetheless, the price He paid does not cover the rewards in Heaven! Granted, we will get access to the fun, the joy and some gifts from Dad in Heaven. However, the choice is ours to decide through the way we live our lives (for Christ down here) whether or not to enter the New Jerusalem, whether or not to receive rewards in Heaven, or better yet, whether or not to have a mansion in Heaven.

"Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal." Matthew 6:19-20 (NKJV).

Chapter III

Heaven

When it comes to the reality of Heaven and spiritual life, things are not as simple as in the physical.

The Heavens and the heavens of Heavens are concepts that we are not used to down here and it can be a bit confusing.

Let's consider what we refer to as the "third heaven" for instance. This is an actual place; a Heaven layered with heavens, so to speak; it is the place of which Jesus Christ said in *John 14:2-3 (NKJV)* *"In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also."*

This New Heaven, that we can call Dad's House, is the same place mentioned in *Revelation 21:1 (NKJV)* *"Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea."*

So, our present heaven and earth, along with the sea which is the darkness/chaos of the second heaven will all pass away. This is how Dad is making all things new according to *Revelation 21:3 (NKJV)* *"And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, 'Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.'"*

Therefore, what we are considering "third heaven" right now is actually the New Heaven that Dad created anew, because of the war

that took place in the other Heavens during the fall of Lucifer and other angels.

In other words, the New Heaven is only one Heaven out of the Kingdom of Heaven aka Kingdom of Light. It is like the new headquarters of the Kingdom of Heaven.

In fact, we are not going to grasp the cosmic size of the Kingdom of Heaven until everything gets wrapped up down here. That is when Dad is going to unveil to us the true magnitude of His Kingdom, The Kingdom of Heaven; that is eternity in Its full glory.

Until then, we are simply going to call the New Heaven (Dad's House) aka the "third heaven" from ours, Heaven.

So, Heaven is a place and It is surrounded by thick clouds, darkness and lightning as mentioned in *Psalms 97:2-4 (NKJV)* "*Clouds and darkness surround Him; Righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne. A fire goes before Him, And burns up His enemies round about. His lightnings light the world; The earth sees and trembles.*"

The clouds, darkness, thunder and lightning serve as a barrier to prevent intruders from coming in to Heaven. As a result, only those who have Dad's permission can pass through to enter Heaven.

Now, the way Heaven is laid out is like a disc (millions of miles across) with the center part being lit up, because that is where Dad's Throne is located.

There are layers of heavens in Heaven; one heaven on top of the other and they mount up for thousands of miles. Hence, it is said in *Hebrews 12:22 (NKJV)* "*But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels,*"

Because there is no gravity, the heavens within Heaven can pile up high, one on top of the other for thousands of miles with each upper heaven being smaller than the lower one. As a result Heaven appears to

look like a lit up mountain, Mount Zion, with Dad seated in the seventh heaven, which is also called the Throne Room.

Each heaven has its own sky, reality and purpose, and from one heaven to the next there is at least two hundred (200) miles distance in between. To put it into perspective, the space between each heaven is higher than a satellite above the earth.

Anyways, there is a gate to access one heaven from another. The gates are more like dimensional portals than actual gates like down here. They just open up into the upper heaven, straight forward.

So, coming in from the barrier of clouds, darkness, thundering and lightning, we will arrive to the outer perimeters of Heaven. This is where the journey of the redeemed souls begins. Those who did not get to grow in purity and holiness while on earth will be held in the outer perimeters in order to be taught the Bible, to praise and worship and to surrender to Dad before they can enter the gate into the first heaven of Heaven.

Once inside, the journey continues with each heaven teaching us and preparing us for the next heaven and so on until we make it to the seventh heaven, the Throne Room.

The good news is that there is no time requirement and there is no pressure in Heaven. Everything comes easy and everyone is free to learn at their pace. Learning is more than a joyful experience in Heaven; it is a recreation. Heck, knowledge comes as easy as eating. I mean how easier can you get when you can consume knowledge in a form of a cake or better yet, how fun can it get to learn a lesson by going shopping!? What a blast, and besides, time is not of the essence. You have eternity ahead of you. Therefore the journey, that is the path to the Throne Room can be as long and enjoyable as you want it to be. Better yet, there will be no envying those who worked on their purity while on earth, because they get to go all the way up to their mansions, straight up to the Throne Room to see Dad. Everyone will be joyful for the fact that others made it to Heaven as well. Therefore, there will be no reason for envy; and Yes, there are mansions in the seventh heaven

of Heaven. They are built around Dad's Throne, like a gigantic stadium going on for thousands of miles.

Mind you, the Throne Room is where the show is and everyone wants to go see Dad. Therefore, the mansions built all around the Throne of Dad provide comfort and front row view to the Throne of Dad.

There are three (3) rows of mansions and they are built in a way that one can see Dad sitting on His Throne from their mansion. Because in Heaven our vision is enhanced, we can see things clearly from miles and miles away. As a result one can sit in their mansion around Dad's Throne and watch the show as if they were right there. What an awesome sight to behold!

Now, the mansions around the Throne of Dad are different from the ones in the New Jerusalem. First, they differ in location; one is built around Dad's Throne while the other is located within the New Jerusalem. Second, the mansions around the Throne are built in three (3) rows to accommodate the view into Dad's Throne. Meanwhile the mansions in the New Jerusalem are built in a residential manner; then third, the mansions around the Throne are reserved for those who are able to stand continually before Dad as mentioned in *Revelation 3:12 (NKJV)* "He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. I will write on him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name."

The New Jerusalem is built to replace the old Tabernacle of meeting. It is the new Tabernacle as mentioned in *Revelation 21:2-3 (NKJV)* "Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God."

In The New Jerusalem the mansions are built for residency and administrative purposes.

Each mansion whether around Dad's Throne or in the New Jerusalem, has its purpose and each mansion is built to fit its owner's heart's desires. Dad had specifically designed each mansion according to the heart desires of each one of us. To some, a mansion is a studio apartment, to others it's a three (3) bedroom house, to others, it's a cottage and to others it's a big country house. All will have their heart's desires and there will be no concerns about running out of space either. Each mansion is forever expandable. They are built as separate realms; it is like having an entire universe to yourself. As a result, the size and the space would not matter. Each mansion will have the potential to expand beyond your wildest imaginations.

Now when it comes to other attractions and places to visit besides the New Jerusalem and the Throne Room, within Heaven, we have the Banquet Room (thousands of square miles in dimension) where everyone in Heaven can just go in, sit down and eat as they please. There is also the River of Life flowing all the way down from Dad's Throne and into all the heavens of Heaven. There is also the Records Room (thousands of square miles in dimension) where the records of our lives are being kept in Heaven for judgment. There is also the sea of forgetfulness where the records will be thrown in, after the great judgment.

There are also gardens and flower fields (thousands of square miles in sizes), and many other places and attractions worth visiting.

The attractions and places to visit in New Heaven alone are enough to keep you going for an eternity. So how much more would the Kingdom of Heaven keep you excited for an eternity?! Heck, eternity is not going to be enough for us to visit it all!

Life In Heaven

Have you ever had a joyful sensation about Christmas, a holiday, or a party; that blissful joy and happiness that you never wanted to end? Now multiply that a thousand times and add to it again, then you will begin to get an idea on how you will feel in Heaven. Every day in Heaven is far more animated, far more joyful and far more colorful than the holiday season.

Indeed, Heaven is so real that when you go there, this reality down here feels like an awful dream. In Heaven, your senses are keener and you feel more alive, because there is no death in Heaven.

In Heaven everything is made with light, everything is alive and everything is colorful. Even the air is alive. The trees and the grass are more vibrant and can even communicate with you. The flowers emit such a beautiful fragrance that you feel full just by smelling them. Oddly enough, colors have taste and clouds can be used as carpet flooring.

Everything is bright and yet soft on the eyes, they shine and yet have visible shapes; they're translucent and yet visible and vibrant. The light concept is so different than down here. On earth in order to see an object, light must first shine on it before you can see the details, the colors, the sizes and so on. In Heaven everything emits its own light; whether or not there is light shining on it would not matter, the object will stand out on its own, with details, colors, sizes and so on. Just as down here on earth where physical matter is the substance in our reality, in Heaven light is the substance. Also, everything good that we have down here had first originated from Heaven.

"John answered and said, "A man can receive nothing unless it has been given to him from heaven. " John 3:27 (NKJV).

This means that for everything good that we have down here, Heaven has the upgraded version. I mean from cars, to planes; from amusement parks to shopping malls; from pizza to Chinese food,

Heaven has them all. You are not going to miss anything up there, because whatever you miss down here, you are going to have it up in Heaven and much better.

No need for money either. Gold, diamond and other gemstones are as good as construction material. Therefore, the currency in Heaven is love. Dad's love provides all for you. Meanwhile the Main Attraction is The Throne Room; to get to see Dad.

Time And Space In Heaven

Heaven is not a boring place. There is always something to see something to learn, an attraction to go to and much, much more.

Everything comes easy. Even learning is easy. There is no trial or tribulations in Heaven, just as Jesus Christ said in *Matthew 11:30 (NKJV)*, *"For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."*

In a sense, something that could have taken you one day to learn on earth can take you a thousand years in Heaven. You can take your time and learn at your pace because time does not matter as mentioned in *II Peter 3:8 (NKJV)*, *"But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day."*

Sure, we are going to continue learning in Heaven. Our journey will not stop. However, the process is way different and way easier than down here.

On earth we seek to develop a relationship with Dad while in Heaven our goal is to see Him in the Throne room.

The Throne Room is where Dad is seated on His Throne, big and powerful as described in *Revelation 4:2-11 (NKJV)*, *"Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the*

throne. And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald. Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads. And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. Before the throne there was a sea of glass, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back. The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle. The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!" Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created." "

Again, depending on your level of growth, it might take a journey to go to the Throne Room. Purity is required in order to be able to stand before Dad just as mentioned in *Matthew 5:8 (NKJV)*, "*Blessed are the pure in heart, For they shall see God.*"

For instance someone who gets saved on their death bed and thereupon goes to Heaven; because they didn't get to grow in holiness and purity down here on earth, they will stay in the outer perimeters of Heaven in order to grow in those virtues before entering. They will begin their journey from the outer perimeters of Heaven to The Throne

Room. That journey is also called a path, and in Heaven every path leads to The Throne Room.

No need to stress on that path either. On your path you can stop at the mall for a thousand years, go swim with the dolphins for ten thousand years or go fly with the angels and visit other dimensions for a million years, it would not matter; you are still on your path to The Throne Room.

Time is so irrelevant that a day in Heaven is equivalent to a thousand years on earth. So, whenever you meet someone up there and he tells you that he has been in Heaven a day or so, just know that he means an equivalent of our earthly one thousand years or so.

Moreover there are no nights in Heaven, because there is no darkness in Heaven as mentioned in *Revelation 22:5 (NKJV)* "*There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever.*"

There is always light in Heaven. Nonetheless, there will be moments when the light is less bright; you may call it twilight of some sort, but there will never be a time of dark (night) like on earth. So, there will be bright days and in between there will be moments that are less bright, but there is always going to be light.

Also, because of the scale (in size) of Heaven, the means of transportation are various. By comparison, we do have cars, bikes, trains, air planes and so on like on earth. One thing however, is that the vehicles are made out of gemstones, they don't run on gas and they don't have engines; they are simply powered by Holy Spirit. So there is no such thing as an engine breaking down, corrosion or worse yet, running out of gas. No! Everything is built to last an eternity.

Now, besides the usual vehicles that we are already accustom to, we also have chariots as mentioned in *II Kings 2:11 (NKJV)*, "*Then it happened, as they continued on and talked, that suddenly a chariot of fire appeared with horses of fire, and separated the two of them; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.*"

The chariot and horses are not bound to gravity either; they run on ground and can take flight at will, because they are all powered by Holy Spirit.

Also, walking and running are so primitive in Heaven that we glide, float, hover, or however you would like to call it. Moreover, if that still seems too much for you, just know that you can choose to travel from one place to another at the speed of thoughts; to be taken by the Spirit, so to speak, as mentioned in *II Kings 2:16 (NKJV)*, *"Then they said to him, 'Look now, there are fifty strong men with your servants. Please let them go and search for your master, lest perhaps the Spirit of the Lord has taken him up and cast him upon some mountain or into some valley.' And he said, 'You shall not send anyone.'"*

For instance if you would like to go to a relative's mansion, all you would have to do is to think of it and boom, you're there, no matter the distance.

Because the means of transportation are so efficient in Heaven, space does not matter as much as time does not matter. Hence, time and space do not matter in Heaven.

Babies And Growth In Heaven

It is well known that babies fall under special graces. They usually say that babies go to Heaven when they die. Well it is true! The Bible says in *Matthew 18:10 (NKJV)*, *"Take heed that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that in heaven their angels always see the face of My Father who is in heaven."*

Because of the purity of their hearts, when they die, babies receive special graces and their angels carry them to Heaven, directly to The

Throne Room. This also goes for children who have not yet reach the age of discerning good and evil and those born with specific disabilities.

Some say that the age of discerning good and evil is around seven (7) or eight (8) years old. Either way, the exact age is not the matter, what is at play here is the fact that Dad takes the pure in heart to Heaven when they die.

From a miscarriage, to an abortion, to a still born, the baby is taken directly to Heaven where they either wait for their parents to come raise them or they are raised by other family members already in Heaven.

Aborted babies do not even hold any grudges against their mothers. No! Instead they forgive them and even pray for them so that they can come to Heaven and get to raise them.

For instance, let's consider the scenario of a mother on earth who had a miscarriage and never got to raise her baby. Well! Upon receiving the baby in Heaven, Dad will allow that baby to remain a babe until the mother gets to Heaven and thereupon she will get to experience raising her baby in Heaven. This will fulfill both the mother's and the baby's desires.

Note also that prayer continues in Heaven minus the delays that we experience on earth. From angels to souls in Heaven, we all pray for things that we dearly want. Remember that Heaven runs on Love (Dad's love). As a result, we can ask Him anything that we want, and we will do so in prayer as well.

Family In Heaven

Did you know that right before a loved one enters Heaven; the other loved ones (already in Heaven) are informed about their arrival? So they gather around to welcome the newly arrived. Some would introduce themselves as brothers and sisters that never made it on

earth (because of miscarriage and abortion) while others will be distant relative and so on.

This goes without saying that Dad is really big on family. After all, He wants us part of His family! Hence He adopts us as His sons and daughters.

Yes, The One Who created and set Adam and Eve in a family unit from the beginning is also for family.

That He has established a family structure on earth should be a sign that He surely isn't going to disrupt it in Heaven. Better yet, He is going to perfect it!

The Bible says in *Acts 16:31 (NKJV)*, *"So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."*

Indeed in Heaven, family members are kept together. Furthermore, they have a unique glow proper to their family. This includes: parents, grandparents, cousins, relatives, their angels and even their pets.

When we read the Bible, we see that chariots have horses as mentioned in *II Kings 2:11 (NKJV)*, *"Then it happened, as they continued on and talked, that suddenly a chariot of fire appeared with horses of fire, and separated the two of them; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven."*

So we do know that there are animals in Heaven. Yet, they are not violent, wild and untamed like the ones down here.

They (the animals) do look similar to the ones down here minus the physical nuisance. In Heaven they are well groomed, bigger, smell better and much cleaner. They are more civilized so to speak. They can communicate and hang out and even play with you. Heck, you can swim and talk with the fish and do so without drowning.

"The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, The leopard shall lie down with the young goat, The calf and the young lion and the fatling together; And a little child shall lead them. The cow and the bear shall

graze; Their young ones shall lie down together; And the lion shall eat straw like the ox. The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole, And the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord As the waters cover the sea." Isaiah 11:6-9 (NKJV).

So, rest assured that because Dad loves you much, He also cares much for the things you care about including your pets. Yes! He will bring your pets in Heaven also, so together you and your pet will get to enjoy each other's company for eternity. After all, they are also part of your household.

Chapter IV

Man In Dad's Image

"So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them." Genesis 1:27 (NKJV).

Just as Dad is Father, Son and Holy Spirit, Three in One. So did He create us: body souls and spirit; three in one! Male and female, in Dad's image and likeness!

Dad loves us so much that He created us looking like Him. We were created by Dad to be loved by Him and to love Him.

Indeed, we look like Him as mentioned in *Daniel 7:13 (NKJV)*, *"I was watching in the night visions, And behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him."*

We look like our Father, but that is not all. As we consider our triune state of being body, soul and spirit, we can notice that our body is that outer shell containing the soul and the spirit.

The spirit is that one part that plays a role in our salvation. Once we become born again our spirit comes alive. This translates that Holy Spirit is now residing within us. Therefore, the spirit becomes light.

Without Holy Spirit, our spirit is dull and without light. Also Holy Spirit is The One that teaches us about good and evil, because the soul does not have the capacity to discern good from evil. Hence it is said in *John 6:63 (NKJV)*, *"It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life."*

Without Holy Spirit, our spirit darkens as it interacts with sin and the powers of darkness. However, the powers of darkness cannot access our spirit as much as they can access our soul.

The soul is the essence of who we are: personality, feelings, emotions, will and so on. Therefore, detaining the soul of someone results in detaining the essence of that person.

Moreover, the soul is a spiritual substance that can be fragmented and/or even get stolen altogether. Furthermore, because the physical body is just a shell, the only thing left that really matters is the soul. Hence they want your soul.

Anyways, without Dad, we cannot save our souls from the powers of darkness. That is the reason why Jesus Christ had to die on the cross to redeem us from death (the powers of darkness) aka eternal separation from Dad.

The connection between our spirits and Dad got severed when Adam sinned; and because Dad said in *Genesis 2:16-17 (NKJV)*, *"And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, 'Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.'"*

So, Adam sinned and thereupon bound mankind to death until atonement was made to redeem us; a life for a life!

Adam (as mankind) sinned, so Adam (as mankind) had to die unless another life was given in his place. So, Jesus Christ, the Perfect and sinless Lamb of God, offered up His Life in exchange for ours so we can live. This is how mankind was redeemed through Christ Jesus!

"O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?" The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." I Corinthians 15:55-57 (NKJV).

Jesus Christ's sacrifice also revealed another aspect on why Dad created man in His image and likeness: to inherit all things.

We are Dad's sons and daughters, heirs to His Throne and that is our true identity as mentioned in *Galatians 4:7 (NKJV)*, *"Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ."*

Through Jesus Christ, our redeemer and savior, we were also restored back to our true identity. Our spirit could now be reconnected to Dad through His Son, Jesus Christ aka the Word, Who is also God as mentioned in *John 1:1 (NKJV)*, *"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."*

The Word Became Jesus Christ

In the beginning was the Word and the Word was God in Heaven. To everyone in Heaven He was God because He was not created; He was the firstborn over all creation as mentioned in *Colossians 1:15 (NKJV)*, *"He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation."*

So picture this; before becoming Jesus Christ, He was the Word, the Firstborn and Son of God. This is similar to a son due to sit on his father's throne; he is only heir to the throne by birth right because he has done nothing to prove himself, yet. However, on the day that the son actually goes out to battle and defeats the enemy's champion, on that day the entire kingdom will recognize him as their king. Therefore, by proving himself worthy, the son would have earned the respect and all the glory that comes with the throne; and this is exactly what the Word did against the devil, formally known as Lucifer.

By rebelling against Dad, Lucifer brought evil into Heaven; which was not heard of until then. Therefore, the chaos and the reality of evil came to life when he fell.

Now, if Dad were to punish Lucifer right then and there, it would have triggered another rebellion, because no one before then had ever tasted the fruit of evil. So, no one, except Dad, could tell for sure how evil felt like; just like a baby mesmerized by fire. No matter how many times the parent tells that baby not to touch that fire because it's hot, the baby is going to stick his hand in the fire in order to find out for himself. This is exactly what was taking place in Heaven; Dad's creation that already knew evil by the way, were now about to taste the fruit of evil for the first time.

Being The Wise Dad that He is, He had to let His entire creation taste evil for themselves all while demonstrating to them that the fruit of evil is not worth trying.

As a result, many angels turned evil, they bought into Lucifer's deception, while others stood back skeptical; meanwhile the rest of the angels remained faithful to Dad.

In His omniscient character, Dad had already planned for this; as a result, He cast Lucifer out of Heaven, then Dad, as the Word, came down to earth and took flesh by becoming Jesus Christ as mentioned in *John 1:14-18 (NKJV)*, *"And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John bore witness of Him and cried out, saying, 'This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.' " And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him."*

So, the Word became flesh in the form of Jesus Christ, defeated the devil by dying on the cross and thereupon reconciled His creation back to Himself as mentioned in *Colossians 1:19-20 (NKJV)*, *"For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him*

to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross."

The Final Government

The Word that is now Jesus Christ, through His death on the cross, made Himself worthy of all praise; He was elevated to the highest position according to *Philippians 2:5-11 (NKJV)*, *"Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."*

Now the Word was given a Name above all names, which is Jesus Christ. Furthermore, Jesus Christ got exalted so high that it unveiled a position that did not exist until then. In a sense, the entire creation realized then that the government that has been from the beginning was not the final one, because Jesus Christ is now seated as the Head of the everlasting government as mentioned in *Isaiah 9:6-7 (NKJV)*, *"For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with*

judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this."

In other words, the Word Who was God according to the former government, became flesh through Jesus Christ and earned the trust, the respect and the reverence due to also become the Head/God of the final and everlasting government. This means that by dying on the cross, Jesus Christ not only demonstrated love, grace and mercy, but He also revealed the Father (Dad's everlasting government) to man and to angels.

The head of the serpent was crushed while the entire creation watched and witness humility, truth, righteousness and the Light triumphing over evil; as a result, the fruit of evil was exposed as rotten and unworthy! The angels that were still skeptical regained trust in Dad through Jesus Christ, while the ones that remained faithful to Dad got comforted in knowing that they made the right choice; meanwhile the ones who chose evil were put to shame.

In the midst of all of this, mankind was now free to walk victoriously in their true identity of being sons and daughters of Dad.

From then on, when mankind walks in their identity through Christ, by using their freewill to choose good over evil, mankind overcomes evil with good and therefore passes judgment on the powers of darkness as mentioned in *1 Corinthians 6:3 (NKJV)*, "*Do you not know that we shall judge angels? How much more, things that pertain to this life?*"

By walking in their true identity, mankind is not only judging the powers of darkness by rejecting their fruit as rotten, but he is also proving himself worthy to be heir of the Throne of the final and everlasting government.

A Father of Nations

Being created in the image of Dad comes with a lot of responsibilities. We are called to represent our Father from earth to Heaven.

As a male, Dad created us to embody His image of a Leader, Warrior, Untamed, Wild, Strong, Powerful, Provider, Protector and so on. Yes! As a male, you are born to be a leader.

2. To become a sacrifice. This means that a leader is strong enough and therefore willing to carry the burden for others, so that others do not succumb to the weight of it. A leader understands the honor in laying down his life for others.

3. To be compassionate. This is expressed through standing in the gap for those experiencing hardship. Compassion is demonstrated through a leader's ability to recognize struggling signs and to step in to help because he understands that everyone, including himself, needs help sometimes.

So, a great leader will not only know when and how to stand in the gap, but he will also do so without complaint. Furthermore, a great leader will extend grace by picking up where others have fallen short or made mistakes because he also understands that we all, including himself, fall short and make mistakes sometimes.

As a result, a great leader, because of his great understanding, will carry on his leadership with love instead of complaint.

These fundamentals are supposed to be developed from home, in a family structure. They are the characteristics of true fatherhood at the image of our heavenly Father.

As a result, a father is not highly regarded by how many children he has, but rather on how well he leads his family.

"(for if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the church of God?)" 1 Timothy 3:5 (NKJV).

Once a man is capable to demonstrate great leadership in his house, then he can expand that great leadership to the church and to society.

By addressing the fundamentals of great leadership in a family structure we can begin to understand why Dad allowed mankind to have children the way we do, it is so we can learn to love and to develop great leadership skills along the way. Yes, being fruitful and multiplying is part of having children; however, there is a deeper meaning to fatherhood and there is a difference between having a child, learning to love and developing great leadership skills.

Let's dig a little deeper by considering the fact that Dad said to love our neighbor as ourselves, yet without ever saying to love our children as ourselves. Wouldn't this imply that we ought to raise our

children to become our neighbors as well, and therefore suggesting that our children are also our neighbors? If that is the case, wouldn't it confirm that having a child would also serve as a teaching process to learn to love our neighbor?

Mind you that many parents with children fail to love their children, let alone to love their neighbor, because if they cannot love the child who came from them, how could they love a neighbor who is not related to them?

In the same way, we have people without children that are capable of demonstrating love beyond the love of those with children. Jesus Christ is the ultimate example of that kind of love.

In other words, having children is one way to learn to love and show compassion, and to develop great leadership skills, but it is not the only way. Being a father is not determined by how many children you have, but rather based on how much love and compassion you demonstrate. In sum, becoming a great leader is solely based on an individuals' willingness to pay the price for love, growth and becoming greater.

If a child is raised to become our neighbor, then the other way around is possible as well. To love our neighbor as we would our own child.

As a result, loving his neighbor as himself would qualify a great leader to be regarded as a father to his neighbor and therefore, a father to his community. Whether or not he has children of his own would be irrelevant because the reach of his fatherhood would stretch beyond that of his immediate family.

Therefore, there is hope for the bachelor as well as the childless to strive to become a great leader, a father of nations.

If you dare to pay the price to become a great leader, you will experience children on a whole other dimension. Your fatherhood will be limitless because children that you didn't even give birth to, will come to your bosom and call you father. Yes! Great leaders are fathers

to nations. Therefore, strive to reflect your heavenly Father by becoming a father of nations!

Just the same as a man is born leader, a woman is born a mother.

"And Adam called his wife's name Eve, because she was the mother of all living." Genesis 3:20 (NKJV).

Whether she has children of her own or children from another, a woman's motherhood transcends flesh and blood, age and race. Her power to nurture, to bond and to bear life goes far beyond physical bearing.

"Sing, O barren, You who have not borne! Break forth into singing, and cry aloud, You who have not labored with child! For more are the children of the desolate Than the children of the married woman," says the Lord. "Enlarge the place of your tent, And let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; Do not spare; Lengthen your cords, And strengthen your stakes. For you shall expand to the right and to the left, And your descendants will inherit the nations, And make the desolate cities inhabited." Isaiah 54:1-3 (NKJV).

Chapter V
